

Moses Smote the Rock
Exodus 17: 6

Moses represents the law of God. God sent forth his Son made of a woman because the children were flesh and blood. God sent forth his Son made of a woman, made under the law. The law said of Christ Jesus: he is holy, spotless, no sin in him, he is fit to make himself a sacrifice as the substitute to suffer the wrath of God in the place of those God gave him.
